Dear AustCham Member,

Thank you for your interest in nominating for a Board of Director position.

AustCham's success depends on a high level of commitment from each member of the Board of Directors (BOD). The BOD oversees the general affairs of the Chamber, as well as contributing new ideas and actively assisting in the successful execution of all AustCham initiatives. Below you will find an outline of the candidature and election process.

Candidature & Election Guidelines

1. Eligible Candidates

- A. Eligible Candidates are defined as being <u>Company Member Representatives</u>, <u>Nominee</u> <u>Representatives or Individual Members</u>, who have fully paid their 2021 AustCham <u>Memberships fee</u>.
- B. An Eligible Candidate can only be validly proposed by a Voting Member and be seconded by another Voting Member
- C. Reciprocal nomination proposals are not permitted.
- D. Proposers should email a completed copy of the Nomination Form (attached) to AustCham's Executive Director during the Nomination Period (refer paragraph 3).

2. Voting Members

A. Each Sponsor Member, Corporate Member, Special Company Member and Individual Member are entitled to one vote each.

3. Nomination Period

- A. The Nomination Period will open on 12:00 AM on Thursday, November 11 and close at 11:59 PM on Friday, November 26, 2021.
- B. <u>Nominations received after the Nomination Period will be deemed invalid.</u>

4. Election Process

- A. The Election Period will open at 12:00 am KST on Friday, December 3, 2021 and close ten working days later at 11:59 pm KST December 17, 2021.
- B. Votes received outside of these times will be deemed invalid.
- C. Applicants will be informed within a week after the election closes and the election results will be officially announced at the 2022 AGM in February 2022.

5. Voting Process

A. For a vote to be valid, voters must select SIX (6) nominees from the list.

6. Directors Duties

- A. Directors are expected to serve for a period of two years.
- B. Directors are required to attend monthly Board meetings normally on the second Wednesday of each month at 7:00pm KST. Please note that any director that fails to attend three consecutive board meetings may be removed from the board.

- C. Directors are expected to contribute to and participate in activities conducted by AustCham Korea, with efforts to serve on more than one committee.
- D. Directors are expected to regularly attend and encourage support AustCham functions, including forums and social events.
- E. Directors should be willing to Chair or sit on a sub-committee for various initiatives throughout the year.
